“The Parable of the Hidden Treasure captures our imaginations just as it would have for the working-class Galileans to whom Jesus first taught it. We see something of how precious we are to God in that *we* are the treasure in this story! Some scholars have good reason to think that the treasure refers to Israel. I only agree to the extent that many Jews became believers, much to the Lord's delight.

I believe that the Lord Himself is the buyer in this parable. Because He knew that there were some people in the world who would trust Him, the Lord gave His all, His Own life, to purchase the world, which was the field. He did that by dying on the cross for the sins of the world. The greatest wonder is that after He paid so much for us He considered it a bargain! It certainly was a fantastic deal for us.”
